Accessibility Guide

Travelling to the Centre

West Oxford Community Centre can easily be reached on public transport.

- **Oxford train station** is a quarter of a mile from the Centre (from the main station exit turn west (right) on the Botley Road under the Railway Bridge. Staying on the right hand side of the Botley Road, you will reach the Centre just after you pass the allotments. St Frideswide's church is opposite.)
- **Many buses** run past the centre. The stop is called 'Osney Island'. All of the number 4 buses (4, 4A, 4B) run frequently along the Botley Road. The 400 Park & Ride and the Brookes Bus also pass the Centre.
- There is **ample cycle parking** outside the Centre.
- **There is limited parking** in front of the Centre, with a reserved disabled space. There is much more car parking available at the excellent 'Seacourt' Park and Ride at the ring road end of the Botley Road.
- There is a useful **map** on the website www.woca.org.uk if you need to know where to find the Community Centre.

Accessible areas

West Oxford Community Centre is **accessible to wheelchair users**. There are no steps to get in or around, although you may find the front door is hard to open without assistance, and some of the interior fire doors are also heavy. There is a unisex accessible toilet just to the right of the entrance. The women's toilets are located to the left and incorporate a wheelchair stall.

The Reception desk is fitted with a **hearing loop**.

Equipment

Equipment available includes:

- portable hearing loop for use in the Mary Town Room & the Main Hall.
- cups and saucers for 75 people, wine glasses for 100 people, kettle.
- data projector, overhead projector (ohp), slide projector and screen.
- flipchart stands, small TV, Video / DVD Players, portable PA System.

All of these items must be requested at time of booking!

Please note, there is no public telephone at the Centre. Please ensure you are able to make a phone call if you need to.
